## ORDINANCE NO. 94-9

## AN ORDINANCE REGULATING SPECIAL EVENTS WITHIN MANZANITA

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF MANZANITA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approval of Special Events. Except as provided for in Section 3, any special event shall be reviewed and approved by the City Council. For purposes of this Section, a special event is an outdoor activity sponsored by an individual, group of individuals or organization the purpose of which is to sell, trade or display goods or services, or to utilize the city as a location for artistic performances or athletic or spectator events. Any special event shall be of a type and scale that is compatible with the ability of the city to accommodate the request. Final interpretation of any provision of this ordinance rests with the City Council.

Section 2. Special Events Criteria.

- (1) Sponsors of a special event shall be an established Tillamook County business or non profit organization.
- (2) The special event sponsor shall complete an application for city staff review. Applications shall be submitted to the city at least 15 working days prior to the Council meeting date which is scheduled for Council review of the application.
- (3) The Council shall review all application information and evaluate the event site characteristics, traffic and parking impacts, sanitation requirements and noise. Upon completion of their review, the Council shall approve, approve with conditions or deny the request.
- Section 3. Exempt Activities. Food concessions operated by non profit organizations in conjunction with a larger community event may be permitted by the City Manager.
- Section 4. Penalties. Violation of a provision of this ordinance is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 with each day a violation continues constituting a separate offense.
