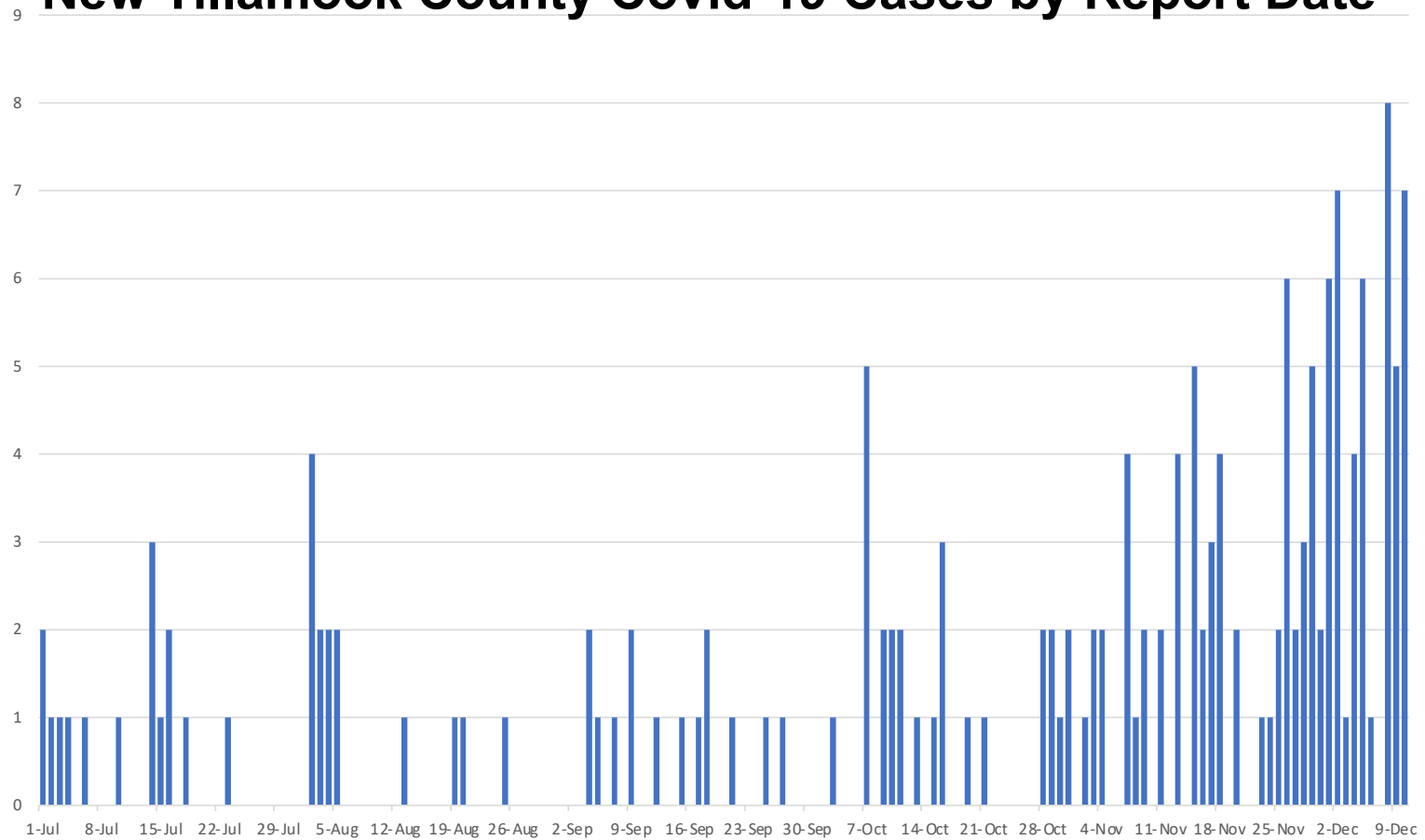

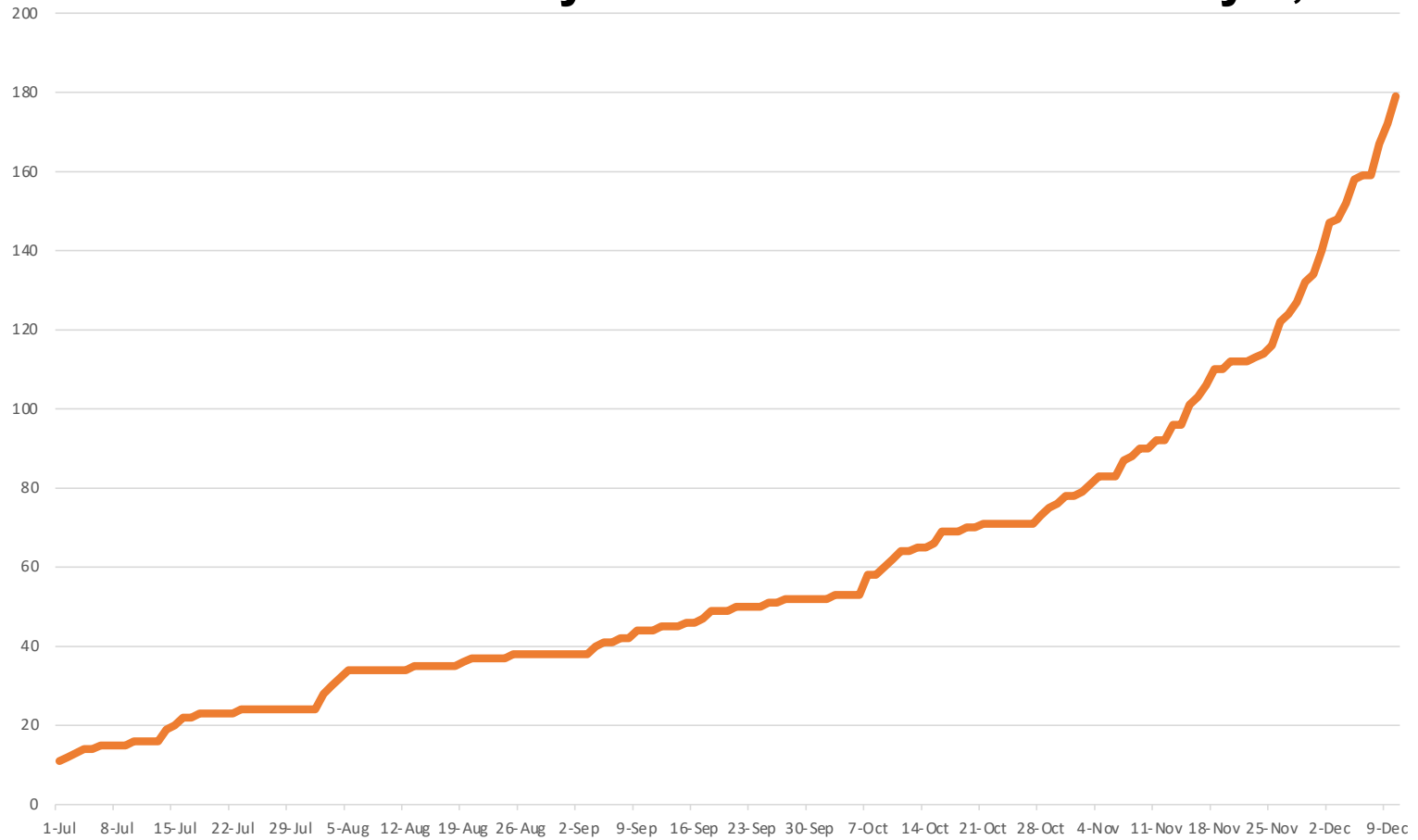
New Tillamook County Covid-19 Cases by Report Date

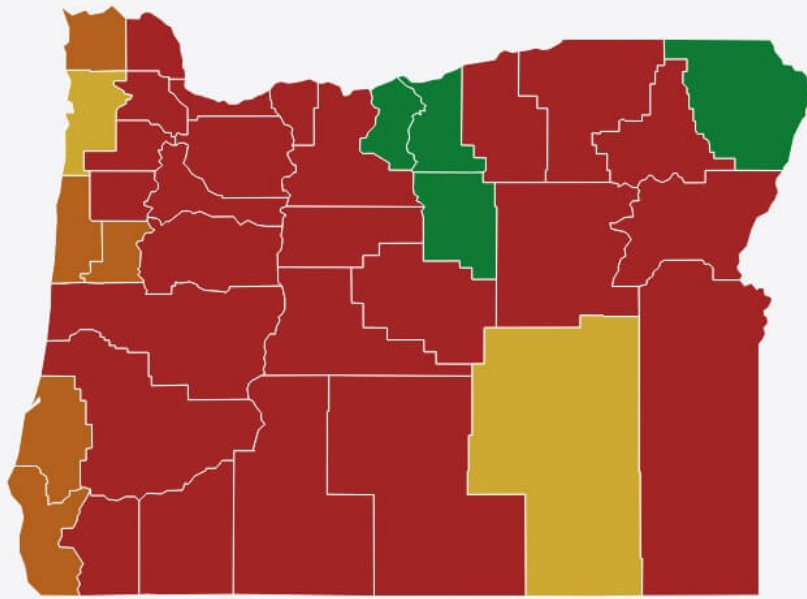

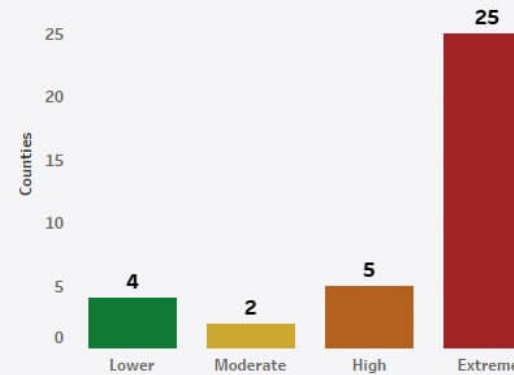

Tillamook County at Moderate Risk Level for 12/3-12/16

Tillamook County Risk Level Calculations

Currently (12/3-12/16) Now designated **Moderate Risk** Level for 2 weeks

cases from 11/15-11/28 **31**

Test positivity from 11/11-11/28 **4.5%**

Wk 1: “Warning Week”: “Would be **High Risk**” Level based on 11/22-12/5 data

cases from 11/22-12/5 **48**

Test positivity from 11/22-12/5 **5.6%**

Wk 2: “Movement Week”: Likely will be **Extreme Risk** based on 11/29-12/12 data

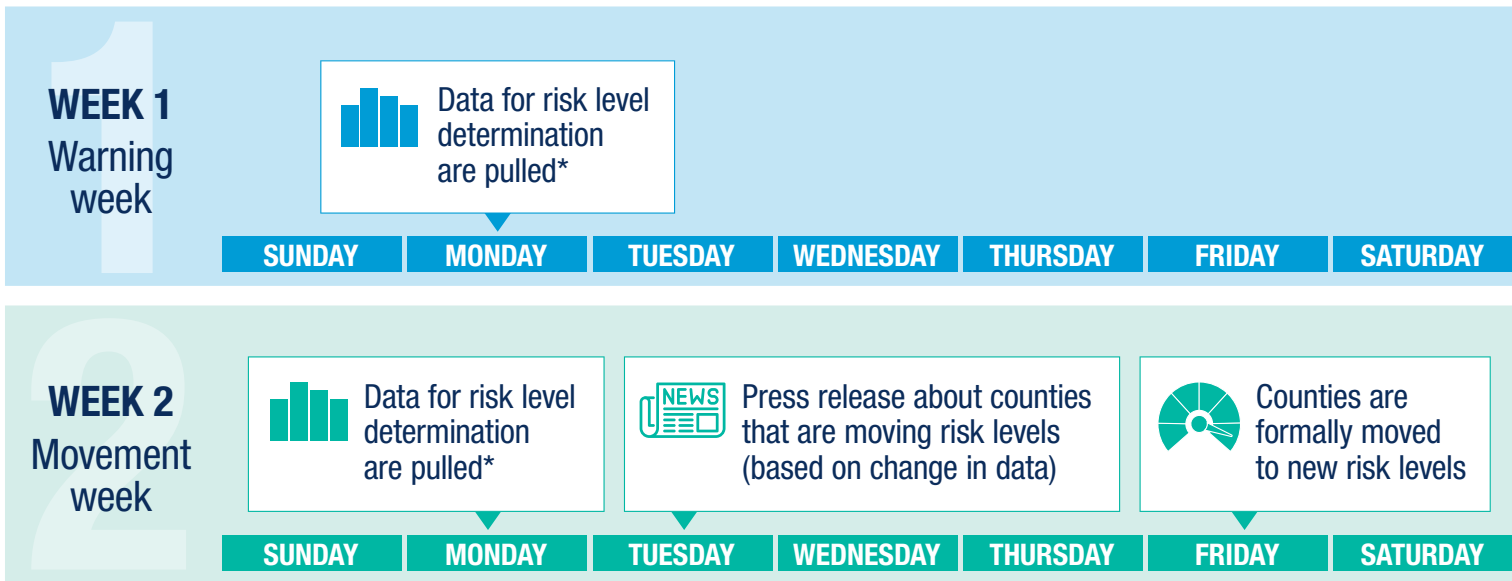
cases from 11/29-12/12 **52** so far (2 days remain in period)

If there are 60 or more cases in these 2 weeks, Tillamook Co. will be at Extreme Risk Level starting Friday 12/18

Criteria for Each Risk Level Tier for Oregon Counties, Dec. 3, 2020

Disease Activity	Lower Risk	Moderate Risk	High Risk	Extreme Risk
Rate of COVID-19 cases per 100,000 over 14 days (counties with 30,000 or more people)	<50.0	50.0 to <100.0	100.0 to < 200.0	≥200.0

Percentage test positivity over previous 14 days	<5.0%	5.0% to <8.0%	8.0% to <10.0%	≥10.0%
