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Project Overview


- Project purpose: Rehabilitate existing park infrastructure
- Projects are funded by State General
 Obligation (GO) Bonds
- Construction will begin Fall 2024 and extend into Summer 2025
- The park will be closed for the duration of construction.






2024/2025 Park Improvements include:

- Upgrade the park water main
- Replace water services in ABC camp loops
- Replace water and electrical services in DEF loops
- Add a new restroom to serve C and D loops
- Renovate 9 campsites to improve accessibility
- Repave and add safety features to the existing park entry road
- Connect the south day use restroom to the sewer system
- Improve horse concessionaire sites in the south day use area

Anticipated Construction Schedule:

Park Closure during Construction

October 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025*

- Schedule could be impacted by a variety of factors:
 - County Land Use and Permitting
 - Contracting
 - Unknown underground conditions
 - Weather

* Subject to change as the project develops.



Construction Traffic Management:

- Construction traffic will be directed to primarily utilize
 Necarney City Road and the Garey Street entrance
- Limited construction traffic will enter through the Horizon Lane entrance off Necarney Boulevard to work on staff cabins and the water main, and at times during the entry road paving.



Unfunded potential future projects:

- Boat ramp parking lot restoration/repaving.
- Boat ramp overflow parking lot paving.
- Boat ramp repair/replacement
- Dump station relocation
- Relocate and expand Hiker/Biker Camp
- Adding a new camping loop with cabins, group camp, and restroom
- Adding a new cabin loop
