COUNCIL RESOLUTION No. 25-

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANZANITA, OREGON
DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY AND RATIFYING ACTIONS IN
RESPONSE TO THE STATE OF EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Manzanita is experiencing unstable land conditions in certain areas of the City that present a credible risk of landslide; and

WHEREAS, a significant storm event is forecasted to impact the region, with heavy rainfall and wind expected to exacerbate slope instability and increase the likelihood of landslides and downed trees; and

WHEREAS, these conditions pose an imminent threat to nearby homes, public infrastructure, and the safety of residents and emergency responders; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated impacts may require immediate action, emergency contracting, coordination with other agencies, and deployment of resources beyond normal procedures; and

WHEREAS, ORS 401.309 authorizes the governing body or designated official of a city to declare a local state of emergency when conditions exist that threaten life, property, or public safety; and

WHEREAS, ORS 279B.080 authorizes the head of a contracting agency or designated person to make emergency procurements to alleviate emergency conditions, with such competition, or no competition, as the head of a contracting agency or designated person determines is feasible or prudent under the circumstances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANZANITA:

Section 1. A Local State of Emergency is declared to exist within the City of Manzanita, effective immediately.

Section 2. The City Manager, Leila Aman, or her delegate is authorized to take all actions on behalf of the City that are necessary to protect life, property, and public safety, including the expenditure of emergency funds, procurement and execution of emergency contracts, reassignment of personnel, coordination with local, county, and state agencies, and implementation of emergency measures as needed.

Section 3. All actions taken by any officer or employee of the City to accomplish the intent and purposes of this resolution, are hereby approved, authorized, affirmed, confirmed and ratified in all respects.

Section 4. This resolution shall remain in effect until at least January 8, 2026, but may be extended as necessary.
